In a psycholinguistic experiment, I investigated the role of structural priming in language change of Turkish spoken in the Netherlands. I explored (1) whether language coactivation results in a cross-linguistic structural priming effect on subject pronoun use, and (2) whether this effect would be modulated by speakers' language dominance.
